## **Bradbury Court, East Clayton Farm, Highly Commended In Sussex Heritage Trust Awards 2011 7 July 2011**

Bradbury Court East Clayton Farm has been Highly Commended in the Large Scale Residential category in the annual Sussex Heritage Awards 2011 which were announced at an awards dinner on 6<sup>th</sup> July.

The residential development commissioned by charity Lorica Trust, is a conversion, restoration and extension of dilapidated National Trust farm buildings to form 8 independent living units and ancillary facilities for young people with profound and multiple disabilities (PMLD).

Sussex Heritage Trust is a Registered Charity established in 1977 to preserve, improve and encourage the appreciation of the architectural and natural heritage of Sussex. The Awards Scheme, started in 1998 and serves to promote many fine examples of conservation, preservation and rejuvenation projects across the county.
